Prelude¹

anting to be true to the Spirit, and with the authority it possesses, the [55th General] Chapter approved almost unanimously the decisions concerning the merger of provinces and the procedures to be followed. Such a merger offers us new possibilities, but it is not an end in itself; it is, rather, the beginning of a new stage, one both demanding and full of hope, in which priorities will have to be established, and adjustments made to ministries. We will have to be open to new initiatives, giving new life to the charism and to the mission of the Order [of Augustinian Recollects]. From now on, each province will constitute a new reality that goes beyond its past history, its name, the number of religious, and the juridical process of coming into being. As a living part of the Order, each province will ensure that it can count on "a sufficient number of brothers and sufficient resources of whatever is necessary to function autonomously with regard to the religious life, formation, administration, and finances"2. Therefore, it is to draw up a plan for the restructuring of its houses and ministries, so as to give impulse and strength on the basis of our charismatic identity: pastoral work with young people and vocations, initial and on-going formation, missions, and ministry to those on the margins, evangelization in parishes and colleges, and the care and attention offered to our elderly and sick brothers. The Chapter has issued a call to organize our life in such a way that the love which leads us to fraternal communion,



and "stirs up the brothers in the service of the preaching of the Gospel"³, should well up from within. It's about a call not to be content with a restructuring that indulges in archaeology or nourishes useless nostalgias, but rather lights the inspiring flame of the Spirit to prepare the wineskins fit for the new wine. Only in this way will we see and touch the wounds of Christ and experience the challenge of the wounds of our fellow human beings. Only in this way will be able to go out to the margins to cure and to be cured.⁴ The changes demand prayer, listening, openness, dialogue, sacrifice, and a willingness on the part of everyone. They also demand humility and sincerity, to seek the path together and always value our brother. The Lord has entrusted us with the task of carrying out the Order's mission today, within its diversity of cultures and ministries.



became no personal queries but a solemn command to love not self but God, to prioritize nothing less than the needs of the Province of St. Ezekiel Moreno, and to serve the Mother Church more than anything else. These, the capitulars, took to heart as the 7th Provincial Chapter unfolded.

The Talavera House of Prayer, a convenient residence of all provincial chapters, was at its usual welcoming and friendly self. The little-black image of *La Salud*, like a mother hen that gathers her brood under her wings, (cf. Mat 23:37) loomed large in the conference hall guiding her beloved children toward a maturing life process. Likewise, St. Ezekiel Moreno, our patron saint, silently stood by the side looking at his cherished brothers and sons crafting a path of life for the youngest Province of the Order dedicated to him. The prayers and greetings from the Augustinian Recollect communities of the nuns, sisters, priests and brother religious, the Secular Augustinian Recollect Fraternity (SARF) and friends of the Recollect family added to the convivial and openhearted discussions among the friars. The recollect movement is indeed a living testimony of a life lived in "one soul and one heart intent upon God."²

Creators of Communion

This 7th Provincial Chapter echoes the slogan of the 55th General Chapter, to be "Creators of Communion"³ which had been the challenge posed by Pope Francis to the capitulars in the said General Chapter.⁴ To become creators of communion is a living and continuing imperative to re-interpret our very own charism within the social, political, and religious context in this part of the world and in this 21st century. It is likewise an alternative and relevant articulation of what Recollect holds dear to his heart, memory and conscience—fraternal life in community.



Consecrated Life: A Witness of the Gospel

On the third year of the quadrennium, the Philippine Church will celebrate the 500th anniversary of the entrance of Christianity to the Philippine shores (March 16, 1521-March 16, 2021). This will "be a grace-filled blessing for the church" as she rekindles the very roots of her faith. A faith that helps her sense the great joy of believing and renews her wonder at the vast horizons which faith opens up.6

The history of the Recollects is deeply entrenched in the succeeding years of evangelization of the Philippine society. The recollect religious labored to create settlements, organized parishes, and introduced devotions to Mary like Our Lady of Consolation, *Ina Poon Bato*, Our Lady of the Pillar, Our Lady of Mount Carmel, and *La Salud*. Beyond these missionary and pastoral endeavors, they remained faithful to their consecration and lived the vows embracing the challenges and difficult circumstances of the moment.



The different anniversary celebrations of the past triennium and within the next quadrennium are solemn testimonies of the Order's continuing presence and evangelical engagement with society and culture. Worth mentioning here, from among many, are the following: 400th anniversary of Augustinian Recollect presence in Cavite (1616-2016), 400th anniversary of the arrival of the oldest image of Our Lady of Mount Carmel de San Sebastian in the Philippines (1618-2018), 400th anniversary of the Augustinian Recollect presence in Cebu (1621-2021), 400th anniversary of the San Sebastian Convent (1621-2021), 600th death anniversary of San Vicente Ferrer of Talisay, Negros Occidental (1419-2019), 400th anniversary of the Augustinian Recollect presence in Mindanao (1622-2022) and Palawan (1623-2023), 385th anniversary of the arrival of La Salud (1634-2019), 170th anniversary of the evangelization of Negros (1848-2018), 75th anniversary of the University of San Jose-Recoletos (1947-2022), 50th anniversary of Colegio San Nicolas de Tolentino-Recoletos, Talisay, Negros Occidental (1971-2021), and 20th anniversary of the Province of St. Ezekiel Moreno (1998-2018).

Service to Humanity

These anniversary celebrations are not only the Order's and the Province's crowning glory of evangelization, but are also barometers through which all efforts and commitments to new evangelization will be gauged. The desire to be creators of communion impels every religious to live fully his consecration i.e. to "commit ... to the total surrender of himself to God, to the imitation and to the most radical and free following of Christ, in a life lived more for Him and for his body, which is the Church." This consecration translates itself to the outpouring of self in pastoral ministries and service to humanity and culture in mission station. Every religious assigned to the school apostolate is to oblige himself in upgrading our learning standards, making our institutions centers of excellence, and teaching our students to be learned in the *tatak Rekoleto*8 values and spirituality.



After having fulfilled the solemn mission, the capitulars entrust to every religious, to those who belong and are connected to the Augustinian Recollect family, and most specially, to those who will shepherd the Province to new horizon in the succeeding quadrennium, a pledge, a solemn promise of undertaking, a primary goal:

 - e. Commission on Communications Recoletos

- g. Commission on Finance and Resource Mobilization – Recoletos

- 3. Emphasize and integrate in the LAMP of the community the following:
 - a. Practice of silence in the clausura, individual room, chapel and oratory.
 - b. Observance of Silentium Magnum*
 - c. Emphasis on silence during annual retreat and monthly recollection.
 - d. Prompt Attendance in the communal acts.

Timeframe: Throughout the quadrennium

4. Implement the practice of weekly community meetings and monthly renewal (cf. LAMP OAR, C.8).

Life of prayer

- 5. Ensure and monitor that the following practices are updated and implemented in all communities (cf. LAMP OAR, C. 9-10.):
 - a. *Lectio divina* and divine office in the community and, as decided by the community, with the laity.
 - b. Care of the Eucharistic celebration and everything attached to it (vestments, vessels, linens, signs and symbols, music and instruments, etc.) and surrounding it (sacristy, oratory, baptistery, mortuary, columbary, ossuary, adoration chapel, cemetery, etc.). (cf. FV 1.1)
 - c. Monthly prayer intentions of the community (vocation: 4th day of the month, mission: 28th day of the month, etc.).

Timeframe: Within the quadrennium

6. Prepare and implement a program of formation in liturgy and Augustinian Recollect prayer for the religious and the lay collaborators in every community.

Persons Responsible: Prior Provincial and Council with the Secretariat of Spirituality and

Formation, Local Prior and community, Section for Spirituality and Liturgy

Timeframe: Within the first year of the quadrennium

Experience of poverty

7. Set-up concrete commitments and advocacies on social apostolate aligned with the ARCORES-Filipinas as expression of our life of poverty and charismatic identity. (cf. LAMP OAR, C.11).

Persons Responsible: Local Prior and community, Commission on Social and Ecological Concerns-Recoletos

Timeframe: Throughout the quadrennium

ARSE

- 8. Continue the translation, publication and dissemination of the Augustinian Recollect Spirituality materials prepared by the "Team for the Revitalization of the Order." (LAMP OAR, C.1-3)
 - a. Program the training of their multipliers.
 - b. Contextualize the program of the Augustinian Recollect Spirituality Exercises (ARSE) in the Province.
 - c. Establish the ARSE center with a comprehensive program and resources for its operation.

Persons Responsible: Prior Provincial and Council through the Secretariat of Spirituality and Formation

Timeframe: Within the first year of the quadrennium

- 9. Continue the adaptation and application of the Augustinian Recollect Formation Itinerary (ARFI) (cf. LAMP OAR, F.2) in all levels of formation in the Province.

10. Complete the preparation and ensure the seamless progression of manuals (formation, administration, research, evaluation, etc.) relative to the different stages and dimensions of formation as required by government and Church authorities.

Timeframe: Within the quadrennium



11. Study the alternative use, for formation purposes, of Santo Tomas de Villanueva-Recoletos Formation House.

Persons Responsible: Prior Provincial and Council through the Secretariat of Spirituality and Formation; Local Prior and community

Timeframe: Within the first year of the quadrennium

12. Declare Casiciaco Recoletos Seminary as venue for the senior high school program, and comply with the requirements and provide resources for its operation.

Persons Responsible: Prior Provincial and Council; Secretariat of Spirituality and Formation; Local Community

Timeframe: Within the first three months of SY 2018-2019

13. Evaluate the Pre-Novitiate program and revise it as needed taking into account the changes of the curricular offerings of the senior high school and college seminaries.

Timeframe: Within the first year of the quadrennium

14. Ensure that the Novitiate program is aligned with the progressive direction of the Augustinian Recollect Formation Itinerary (ARFI).

Timeframe: Within the first year of the quadrennium

15. Continue the development of Recoletos School of Theology as the Centre for Theological and Augustinian Studies, Culture and Spirituality in the Province.

Persons Responsible: Prior Provincial and Council through Secretariat of Spirituality and Formation; Local Prior and community

Timeframe: Throughout the quadrennium

- 16. Implement the program of formation in preparation for solemn profession, which contains the following (cf. LAMP OAR, F.9):
 - a. Immersion in the religious communities during the Year of community/pastoral integration (cf. LAMP OAR. F 9)
 - b. Participation in the common Month of Preparation Proximate to Solemn Profession (cf. LAMP OAR, F.8)
 - c. Learning of Spanish language (cf. LAMP OAR, F.6).

Persons Responsible: Prior Provincial and Council through Secretariat of Formation and Spirituality; Local Prior and community

Timeframe: Throughout the quadrennium

17. Continue the implementation of the diaconal exposure program in preparation for the formands' pastoral and missionary works.





Persons Responsible: Prior Provincial and Council through Secretariat of Spirituality and Formation; Local Prior and community, Secretariat of Ministerial and Mission Apostolate

Timeframe: The whole quadrennium

18. Revisit the program of formation for Religious Brothers and craft, if needed, a new program considering the new guidelines from the Pontifical Congregations, the Order and the present needs of the Church and society.

Persons Responsible: Prior Provincial and Council; Secretariat of Spirituality and Formation

Timeframe: Within the first year of the quadrennium

Ongoing Formation

- 19. Create a developmental program for ongoing formation (cf. Const. 256-275; LAMP OAR, F.10) such as:
 - a. Leave of absence for a just cause (cf. Const., 408.6; 424.4)
 - b. Religious Renewal (Balik-Nobisyado, cluster gathering, etc.)
 - c. Reintegration program for religious (from leave of absence, exclaustration)
 - d. OAR Assisted Intensive Renewal program

Persons Responsible: Prior Provincial and Council; Secretariat of Spirituality and Formation

Timeframe: Within the quadrennium

20. Implement the mandatory attendance of religious in the programs of ongoing formation (renewal, retreats, updating, etc.).

Timeframe: Within the first year of the quadrennium

21. Adapt the program for the formation of formators of the Order (cf. LAMP OAR, F.2) and incorporate it in the formation priorities of the Province.

Specialized Formation

22. Send qualified religious to take doctoral studies in the specific fields of theology and philosophy to comply with the requirements of Pontifical affiliation and civil recognition of our seminary schools (CaReS and RST) by 2020.

Persons Responsible: Prior Provincial and Council through the Secretariat of Spirituality and Formation

Timeframe: March – May 2018









Ministerial Apostolate

- 23. In consonance with the Life and Mission Project of the Order, the Manner of Administration of the parishes include the following:
 - a. Drawing up a Provincial Pastoral Plan, integrating into it the primary objective of the Province, the Augustinian Recollect charism and the thrusts of the diocese, by highlighting:

- a.1 The intensification of the Augustinian Recollect Spiritual Exercises (ARSE), the practice of lectio divina, and devotions to the Blessed Virgin Mary and saints of the Order.
- a.2 The promotion of the Secular Augustinian Recollect Fraternity (SARF), the Recollect Augustinian Youth (RAY), and Christian Mothers of St. Monica.
- b. Designing and implementing programs for pastors in the field of shepherding, stewardship, spiritual discernment, and finance management.
- c. Drawing up and evaluating the parish's annual pastoral program in coordination with the religious community and the parish pastoral council (cf. LAMP OAR, D.6).
- d. Implementing the consolidated manuals of the Province's Guidelines for OAR Parishes.

Persons Responsible: Prior Provincial, Head of the Section for Ministerial Apostolate, Parish Priests

Timeframe: Within the quadrennium

24. In considering the foundation of new communities or accepting new apostolic commitments, give preference to parishes and mission areas located in the peripheries (cf. LAMP OAR, D.8).

Persons Responsible: Prior Provincial, Head of the Section for Ministerial Apostolate

Timeframe: Within the quadrennium









Mission Apostolate






Social and Ecological Concerns
