R. Both now and forever.

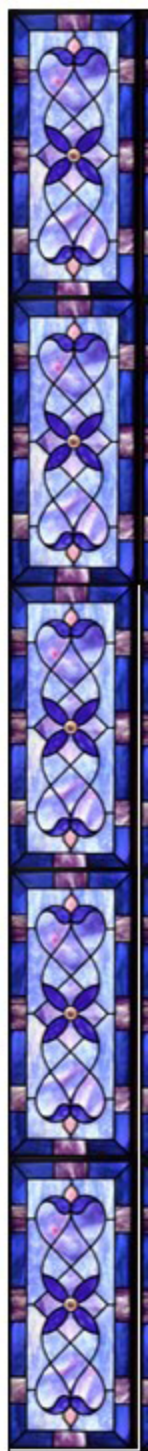

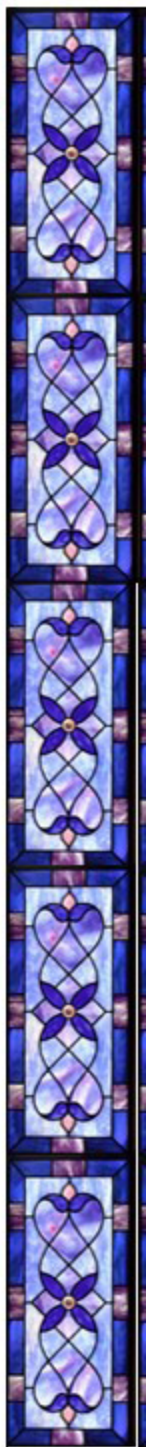

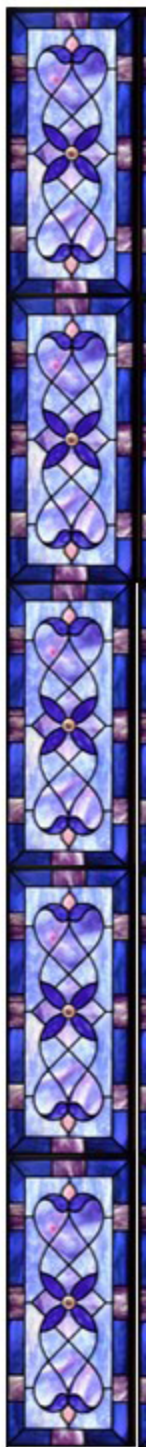
