AUGUSTINIAN VALUES AND PEDAGOGY MAY 14-18, 2019

Course Description:

This 5-day course introduces students to the Augustinian pedagogical principles and values in education that help in the personal and social development of the generation of computer and digitization culture. It shows students, teachers and all personnel that school is first people and that love of God and neighbor is in the heart of the institution.

The course underscores the mission and collaboration of all the members of the school as a community that educates.

Course Learning Outcomes

Knowledge:

students will possess the knowledge and state with confidence the purpose of their life and their need of an education in values that make them realize such desire.

Skills:

students will possess the skills in collaborating, discerning and fraternal companioning in educational activities that lead to their integral development.

Attitudes:

Students will take every member of the educating community first as brother/sister (elder/younger), respectful of boundaries and authorities, and compliant to schools rules and regulations.

Comprehensive Spiritual Formation and Immersion Program for OAR Schools is a program in response to Decision no. 32 of the Life and Mission Project of the Order in the Province of St. Ezekiel Moreno which states, "Design and implement a comprehensive Spiritual Formation and Immersion Program for all religious and lay administrators, teachers, and office staff in all our educational institutions." AUGUSTINIAN MOVEMENT MAY 20 - 24, 2019

Course Description:

This 5 –day course is a general survey of the charismatic evolution of the Order of Augustinian Recollects from the foundation of the order of St. Augustine in 1256 to the establishment of the Augustinian Recollect Province of St. Ezekiel Moreno in 1998.

The course will also expound to students the meaning of charism as service to peoples and structures, how the Order of Augustinian Recollects lived, developed the charism and carried out the mission entrusted to her by the Church through history up to the present.

Course Learning Outcomes

Knowledge:

Students will have the knowledge to see themselves as pilgrims and members of the Church; that in the journey (historical narrative) God accompanies them through religious or consecrated lives to whom he entrusts charisms, which are gifts of God for the service of His people.

Skills:

Students will acquire the skills of community building and collaborating with their authorities: they work together for their welfare and that of the society... aligned to God's plan and design.

Attitude:

Students will see themselves as children of the same Father, benefitted by the charisms (gifts) entrusted to religious or consecrated lives, who are their authorities and fellow companions in the early pilgrimage. (historical narrative)
